SOUTH VIETNAM

Area — 65,726 sq. mi. Geography — The soft-rich flood plain of the Mekong Delta comprises the southern part of the country. Tropical rain forest is the dominant vegetation in the uplands, which include the Dong Nai River in the rugged terrain of the Annamite range. A central plateau region and a narrow strip of coastal plain are the other prominent features. Climate — Year-around tropical climate is found in the south, with monsoon rains in summer and temperatures averaging above 80 degrees F. Central Highlands and mountains experience a cooler season from October to March, with monsoon rains in winter. People — Ethnic Vietnamese are predominant, with small minorities of Chinese, Khmer (Cambodians) and Montagnards (mountain tribes).
